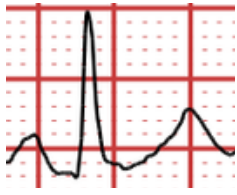


2026–27 SPORTS PHYSICALS

A sports physical that actually looks at the heart

Every preparticipation physical at Evexeya Health meets WIAA requirements and includes an electrocardiogram (EKG) — not just the standard history and exam. Screening echocardiogram is also available for athletes 16 and older.

**Why we include an EKG with every physical**

Sudden cardiac events are rare, but they are one of the leading medical causes of death among young athletes — and a standard history and physical alone may miss the underlying conditions. Momentum on this issue is growing nationally: Florida's Second Chance Act now makes Florida the first state to require EKG screening for high school athletes, beginning with the 2026–27 school year. Wisconsin/WIAA does not currently require it — Evexeya Health includes it anyway, as a standard part of every preparticipation physical we perform.

What the screening echocardiogram looks for

- Valve disease (stenosis/narrowing or regurgitation/leaking)
- Excessively thickened ventricle walls
- Enlarged and/or weakened heart chambers
- Dilated aortic root

IMPORTANT LIMITATIONS

The EKG and screening echocardiogram are screening tools. They cannot diagnose every structural, electrical, or genetic/hereditary heart abnormality associated with serious cardiac events including sudden cardiac death, and no test can guarantee the absolute absence of future cardiac issues. The screening echocardiogram protocol is not designed and is not able to evaluate for congenital coronary artery anomalies. Image quality can be limited by individual body characteristics (for example, being overweight or large breasts); a nondiagnostic result due to these individual characteristics is not grounds for a refund.
